0.2.2 Raw material policy for Gällö Skog

Gällö Timber AB shall as buyers of forestry products/raw materials and in its forestry activities, work for the activities to be conducted in the most sustainable way possible for the environment and for the employees

We'll achieve this through:

- Fulfilling current legislation and following the demands and innovations that the forest certifications bodies has.
 - Ensuring ourselves that the purchased raw material DO NOT originate from:
 - Illegal logging.
 - Forests with high conservational value*.
 - Forests where consuetude or civil rights are violated.
 - Forests with genetic manipulated trees.
 - Natural forests which has been deforested with the purpose of using the area for plantations or other non-forestry usages.
- Conducting the business and improvements as to reduce eventual negative environmental impacts.
- Acquiring raw materials that's to the highest degree is eco-friendly, comes from certified forestry. We will also work to increase the share of certified forest in our area.

The personnel shall be trained and informed so they can satisfy the contents of this policy.

This policy should be public.

If knowledge arises that the raw material comes from controversial sources, then immediate actions will be taken to rectify the situation.

*In Sweden defined as key biotopes according to Skogsstyrelsens definitions and methods. Exception applies to loggings in key biotopes for the purpose of strengthening natural value according to Skogsstyrelsens recommendation.
